Immunizations available at HCPH Clinics through Vaccines for Children Program (VFC)

** Second dose due in six months.

* If not given to child at an earlier age.

[†] Receive annually. If receiving influenza vaccine for the first time should receive two (2) doses separated by at least 4 weeks for children from 6 months to 8 years of age.

[∅] If child has not had chickenpox.

• Given every ten years.

The above schedule is based on the annual Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommended immunization schedule for children and adolescents from birth to age 18 years. The CDC schedule applies to children and adolescents who receive their shots in the United States.

VFC Eligibility Requirements for Immunizations

- ◆ Enrolled in Medicaid
- ◆ An American Indian
- ◆ Receives benefits from CHIP
- ◆ An Alaskan Native
- ◆ Uninsured, does not have health insurance
- ◆ Underinsured
 - Has commercial (private) health insurance but coverage does not include vaccines
 - Insurance covers only selected vaccines
 - Insurance caps vaccine coverage at a certain amount (once coverage amount is reached, child becomes eligible)

Note: Must meet at least one of the VFC eligibility requirements described above .
