



RABIES POST EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS (PEP)

| PET'S RABIES VACCINATION HISTORY | TREATMENT | REGIMEN |
|----------------------------------|---|---|
| Not currently vaccinated | Euthanize Vaccinate** Isolate | Livestock* should be euthanized immediately. Dogs, cats, and ferrets should be euthanized OR vaccinated and isolated. Administer 1.0 ml rabies vaccine immediately and again in week 3 and week 8. Strict isolation for 90 days. |
| Currently vaccinated*** | Vaccinate Isolate | Administer 1.0 ml rabies vaccine immediately. Strict isolation for 45 days. Livestock* can be observed for 45 days. |

*Livestock is defined as cattle, horses, goats and sheep.
 **This option is ONLY available for cats, dogs and ferrets.
 ***Dogs, cats and ferrets are considered currently vaccinated if they have been vaccinated within the last 12 months OR received 2 rabies vaccinations within 12 months of each other and have been vaccinated most recently with a 3 year rabies vaccine within the last 36 months.
