


GENERATOR SAFETY



Keep generators outside
& monitor for CO

Stay safe:

- Before starting your generator, read **product instructions** for proper operation and safety tips.
- **Never use a generator inside your home or garage**, even if doors and windows are open.
- Place generators **more than 20 feet away** from your home, doors, and windows.
- When refueling gasoline- or diesel-powered generators, ensure the power **switch is in the “OFF” position**.
- Immediately **clean up any fuel spills**.
- Install battery-operated or **battery back-up CO detectors** near every sleeping area in your home.
- Check CO detectors **regularly** to be sure they are functioning properly.

Be aware of the symptoms of CO poisoning:

- Headache
- Fatigue
- Dizziness
- Nausea/vomiting
- Confusion
- Seizures
- Loss of consciousness



Get out of the house and seek immediate medical attention if you experience these symptoms
